

## Focus on Key Policies in Brussels and beyond



EBA is the voice of biogas and biomethane in Brussels supporting the interests of your organisation. Our Association works in close cooperation with EU institutions and actively contributes to the legal framework of biogas, biomethane and gasification.

EBA has an extended network across Europe. Our 90 members are national biogas associations, international companies, research institutes as well as private persons.



EU projects - international projects help to develop the biogas sector. EBA is partner in different EU projects (e.g. BIOSURF and Biogas Action). As a company member you can be involved in our research activities and cooperate with EBA in removing existing barriers for biogas and biomethane.

This covers all energetic applications of biogas, including heat, electricity and automotive fuel. The EBA's membership comprises national biogas associations, institutes and companies from over 26 countries across Europe. The member associations include the majority of producers, companies, consultants and researchers in the field of biogas within Europe.

EBA strategy identifies three priorities: to establish biogas as an important part of Europe's energy mix; to promote source separation of household waste with a view to increasing the gas potential; and to support the production of biomethane as vehicle fuel.
